Take a **good** look at the 12 gauge "High Velocity" rifled slug shown here. It weighs 415 grains, travels 1470 feet per second with almost a ton of energy at the muzzle . . . that's **real power** for shotguns. Enough to knock down deer, bear, cougar, fox and other game for keeps.

By actual test, the "High Velocity" rifled slug has proved twice as accurate as old style round ball loads. The external rifling, hollow base and long bullet-type shape cause the slug to travel with accuracy heretofore thought impossible in shotguns. Hunters in states which prohibit the use of rifles for big game hunting will welcome this amazing improvement in accuracy, because it means a **sure** hit.

"High Velocity" rifled slugs are available for 12, 16, 20, and 410 Ga. guns intended for maximum loads and in good condition. They may be used in any boring of gun from cylinder to full choke. Slug weights are: 12 gauge, 1 oz.; 16 gauge, 7/8 oz.; 20 gauge, 5/8 oz.; 410 gauge, 1/5 oz.

Ask your local dealer for "High Velocity" rifled slugs. Test their power and accuracy in your shotgun. Then be sure to carry an ample supply on your hunting trips this fall.
