Take a **good** look at the 12 gauge "High Velocity" rifled slug shown here. It weighs 415 grains, travels 1470 feet per second with almost a ton of energy at the muzzle . . . that's **real power** for shotguns. Enough to knock down deer, bear, cougar, fox and other game for keeps.

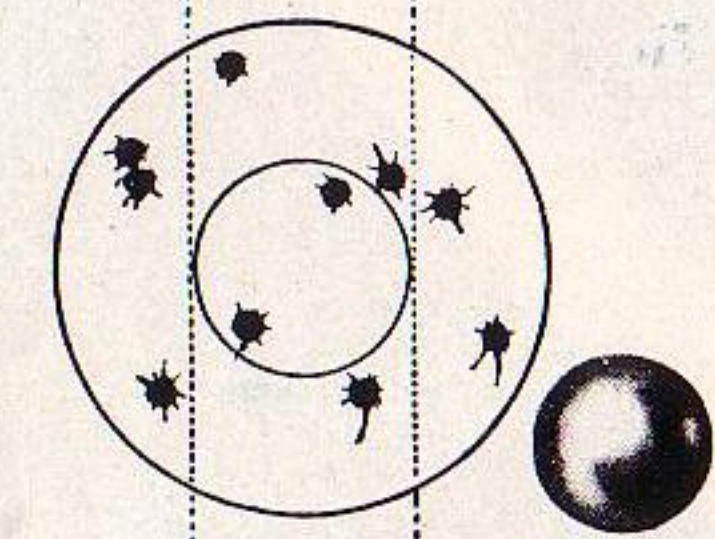
Shotgun barrels are of course smooth bore, but the spiral grooves or rifling on the outside of the slug produces rotation in flight. This feature, plus its hollow base and long bullet-type shape, causes the rifled slug to travel with accuracy and hit with smashing power. Hunters in some states which prohibit the use of rifles for big game hunting will welcome this amazing improvement in accuracy, because it means a sure hit.

"High Velocity" rifled slugs are available for 12, 16, 20 and 410 gauge shotguns, intended for maximum loads and in good condition. They may be used in any boring of barrel from cylinder to full choke. Slug weights are: 12 gauge, 1 oz.; 16 gauge, $\frac{7}{8}$ oz.; 20 gauge, $\frac{5}{8}$ oz.; 410 gauge, $\frac{1}{5}$ oz.

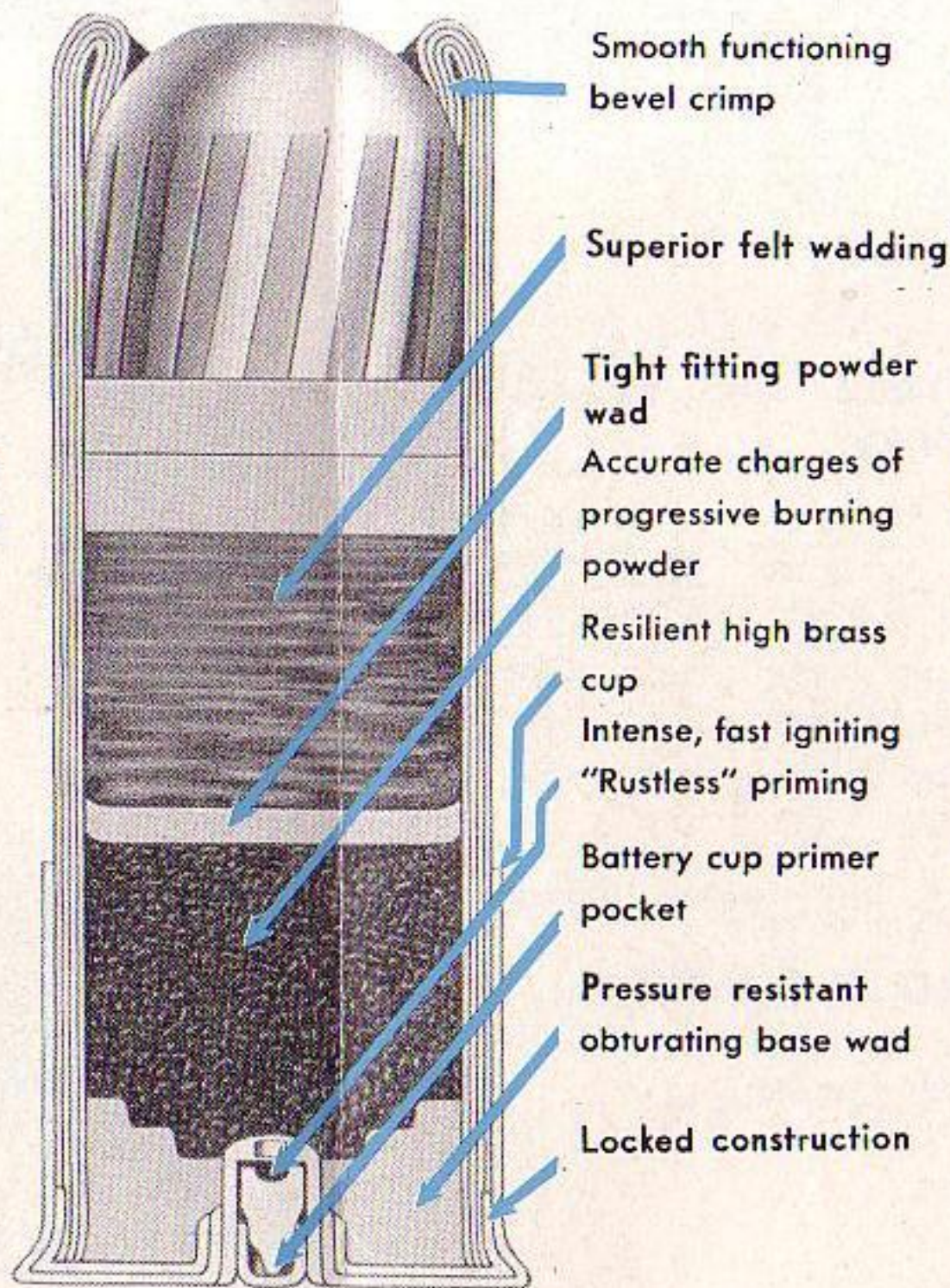
Ask your local dealer for "High Velocity" rifled slugs. Test their power and accuracy in your shotgun. Then be sure to carry an ample supply on your hunting trips this fall.
